### **AGENDA.**

How many darts teams are around Paphos and Coral Bay?

Who are you,where do you play from?How many players do you have?How many boards do you have?

Are you interested in forming a **group**,to exchange dates and play one another on a friendly basis?(**Not necessarily a league**).

A second meeting date to be announced on the night ( to give people a chance to go back to their clubs and relate the discussions of this meeting to their members)at this second meeting 1 or 2 representatives from each club can come together with diaries and plan their friendly fixtures for the forthcoming months. ( Instead of phoning around and seeing which teams are available to play a friendly game).

**Chance to exchange telephone numbers.** Come prepared with the name of your club and a contact telephone number on business cards or just pieces of paper to give to other people.

**To discuss format.**e.g. how many people per team;  
Suggest 8 per team mixed plus 2 reserves.  
Play 2 x 4's plus 4 pairs plus 8 singles.  
To set a time to start games.

**Discuss common ground:** to try to agree on sensible drinks prices charged to visiting teams and supporters by club landlords/publicans.

We would like to point out that at a meeting held last year to discuss the formation of a darts league in Paphos where teams would become members of the Cyprus Darts Organisation,Keo,who were the sponsors and who have already given out dartboards and surrounds to many clubs free of charge and are willing to continue this sponsorship wanted to see a large bottle of their beer being charged at around £1.20c.

### **Any other business.**

**Ask your landlord** if he will be prepared to bring his prices in line with Keo's recommendation for darts matches.What would he be prepared to charge as teams need to know? Some teams may not wish to play at a venue where the drinks are over priced,therefore,if your landlord cannot accommodate sensible prices you may find some teams may not be prepared to play at your pub. (This is from feedback received).

**Distance.** Make sure your members are prepared to travel,in some cases up to 45 minutes.

**MINUTES OF PAPHOS DARTS MEETING HELD ON 1<sup>ST</sup>.NOVEMBER 2006  
VENUE: CORAL BAY DARTS CLUB.**

**This is a reasonable accurate summary of the agenda discussed at the above meeting.**

**All 9 teams present** reported to have at least one match board and should have enough players by December 06.

**All teams** showed a positive interest in arranging friendly games on an organised basis (even a friendly league basis).

**Telephone numbers.** Of teams was exchanged.

**Discussion of format;**

2 x fours,      One game, straight start, double finish 801.

4 x pairs,      “      “      “      “      601.

8 Singles,      “      “      “      “      501.

Eight players per team plus four reserves.

Maximum number of players needed for a match is six.

Captains to make random draw at the beginning of evening to determine games. To be explained at next meeting.

**Match night proposed;** Tuesdays. Arrival times for both teams 7.30pm for 8pm start.

**Home team** to provide food for visiting team (12 people) any more food for the visiting supporters is at the discretion of the home team.

**Suggestion** for food was sandwiches plus chips or other hot snacks.

**Varying drinks prices** were discussed and it would appear that it is impossible to enforce special lower drinks prices for match nights. Again this is at the discretion of the home venue.

It was also pointed out that most teams would only have to visit a minority of venues with higher drinks prices every 18-20 weeks or once per season.

Without losing sight of our objectives we would hope that this would be appreciatively tolerated in the best interests of friendship and playing darts.

**Travelling distances:** this did not seem to be a problem at all.

**Next meeting date** confirmed as Charlie's Bar, Tomb of the Kings Road on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup>. November 8pm start.

**Any other business;** none.
