1. CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

The Chairman reported on details of last season's league and competition results.

2. TREASURER'S REPORT

The Treasurer failed to attend the meeting and several attempts to contact him had failed.

3. RESULT OF FEDERATION BALLOT

It was reported that the vote for joining the federation was 6 for (Frog and Toad 1, Ollie's, Flanagan's, Cockatoos1, Latin Parish and Charlie's Bar) and 3 against (Cockatoos A, Frog and Toad A and Alexander's). No reply had been received from Queen Vic, Lantern, Coral Bay, Aces Bar, Emma's Bar and C.J's.

4. JOINING THE FEDERATION

The Chairman reported that he had spoken to the President of the Cyprus Darts Federation and he had indicated that six teams were sufficient for Paphos to form a league in the Federation.

As a result of joining the Federation it would be necessary for the existing Committee to resign and for two new Committees to be formed, one for the Paphos Federation Darts League and one for the Paphos Darts League.

The Chairman explained that it would be necessary for both groups to hold their own meetings at a future date to elect new Committees.

Bernard Dangerfield suggested that any monies currently remaining should be transferred to the new Paphos Darts League. This was AGREED by the meeting.

5. RESIGNATION OF COMMITTEE

The existing Committee of the Paphos Darts League then resigned.

After the resignation of the Committee, there was a general discussion regarding the advantages and disadvantages of joining the Federation, the two leagues playing on separate nights to enable players to play in both leagues and the formation of Committees.
