ACES BAR ASKED FOR RULE 6.4 (STARTING OF A MATCH) TO BE CHANGED FOR DIVISION ONE TEAMS.

ACES,COCKATOO'S,MESOGI "A" VOTED IN FAVOUR,FROG & TOAD AND LATIN COMMUNITY CENTRE VOTED THEY DID NOT MIND EITHER WAY AND THE SEA HORSE VOTED TO KEEP THE PRESENT FORMAT.

AS A MAJORITY OF TEAMS VOTED IN FAVOUR THE RULES WILL BE CHANGED AS FOLLOWS FROM GAMES PLAYED 27TH.NOVEMBER 2007 ONWARDS.

RULE 6.4A.

DIVISION ONE TEAMS WILL REPEAT THIS FOR EVERY GAME BUT IN THE CASE OF LEGS BEING EQUAL THEN THE PLAYER STARTING LEG ONE WILL START LEG THREE.

RULE 6.4B

DIVISION TWO AND THREE TEAMS WILL THEN START ALTERNATELY.

MESOGI "A" ASKED IF RATHER THAN HAVE A KNOCKOUT IN HOUSE AT THE END OF THE SEASON WE COULD HAVE MANY VENUES PLAYING RATHER THAN HAVE BETTER PLAYERS ELIMINATED IN THE EARLY STAGES.

THE IDEA OF THE LEAGUE SINGLE AND DOUBLES IS FOR ALL TEAMS TO BE ABLE TO SEND THEIR BEST PLAYERS TO THE KNOCK OUT STAGES WITH THE HOPE THAT MANY TEAMS WILL BE REPRESENTED ON FINALS NIGHT WHICH WILL HELP WITH TICKET SALES. IF ONE TEAM DOMINATES THE NIGHT THEN THE ATTENDANCE WILL PROBABLY BE POOR AND THE ATMOSPHERE FOR THOSE TAKING PART WILL NOT BE WHAT THEY DESERVE.

LAST YEAR WHEN THE EVENT WAS HELD AT ONE VENUE FOR EACH OF THE COMPETITIONS WE HAD TROUBLE IN GETTING CHALKERS AND CALLERS AND THIS YEAR HAVING TWO WILL CAUSE US TWICE THE PROBLEM OF LAST YEAR. TO HAVE FOUR VENUES, WHICH IS THE MAXIMUM WE COULD HAVE, WOULD PROVE IMPOSSIBLE.

THE FORMAT WILL REMAIN THAT TEAMS SEND THEIR BEST TWO PLAYERS OR PAIRS TO THE KNOCK OUT STAGES.

IT WAS DECIDED THAT RATHER THAN MAKE THIS A HARD AND FAST RULE IT WILL BE LEFT TO THE CAPTAINS TO AGREE, WITH THE PLAYERS CONCENT, TO THROW NEAREST THE BULL SHOULD THE GAME NOT LOOK LIKE REACHING A CONCLUSION IN A REASONABLE PERIOD OF TIME. THE PLAYER THAT STARTED THE GAME WILL THROW FOR THE BULL FIRST.
